# Immersion: knowledge

#### As Philosophers...

Children are able to talk positively about themselves. They are able to identify features about themselves that are different to others. They are able to say what makes them a good friend and ways they like learning.

# Practice: knowledge

### As Philosophers...

Children extend their understanding of themselves to their reflection of others. They learn to pay compliments and consider what respect means. They extend their knowledge to what makes a good friend and a good learner.

Children are able to pay compliments to others. They know ways is which they can show them respect including being kind. Children recognize when others are being a good friend. They understand what makes good learning and how to challenge themselves.
