#### Dear All,

Well done on another week of following the guidance and trying to keep everyone as safe as possible. Thank you for bearing with us. Our children have, once again, been fabulous and are into the swing of things with lots of learning going on and meeting our behaviour expectations of being Ready, Respectful and Safe. Smart walking in the corridors is helping us stay safe and all is calm in the school.

We have listened to your feedback and have planned a change to our pick up arrangements. This will start from Monday 14th September. Children will be collected in family groups with times allocated according to surnames. Where children in a family group have different surnames they will be available for collection grouped with the eldest child's surname. Where children are not in a family group they will be collected at the time designated for their surname.

#### Sunflowers children who are not being collected as part of a family group should be collected at 2.55pm.

I hope that this makes the collection time less chaotic for people and enables all to follow the social distancing guidelines. We appreciate that there can always be unforeseen events and just ask that you let us know if you are going to be late collecting your child/ren.

We had planned our 'meet your child's teacher evenings for the week beginning 16.11.20. We are considering our options should the guidance remain as it is. For these meetings we will offer a telephone appointment, an email or where either of these options are not suitable, a socially distanced meeting. This is just to let you know that we will still be finding ways to feedback to you (and you to us) despite the challenges of Covid-19.

## COVID

## **VIDEO WARNING**

We have had the following warning from the Gloucestershire Safeguarding in Education manager:

"Gloucestershire Police are aware of a video circulating on TikTok and other platforms such as Facebook, Instagram and Snapchat which shows a male taking his own life. For parents' awareness, the still of this video is an image of a male with a beard, sat at a desk. Whilst social media platforms have removed the original video, it has been widely re-shared and some users are embedding the video within others to trick other users into watching it.

We would like to remind parents that most social media apps, including Snapchat, Instagram and TikTok, are not suitable for people under the age of 13 due to the nature of some of the content shared on these platforms, including this video. We would also urge individuals to report any harmful content they come across on social media to the provider."
